Located on the Campus Deux Lions, the Faculty benefits from an excellent tramway link: the centertown and the station can be reached in 15 minutes. The Faculty welcomes 4500 students each year. These students find a pleasant environment focused on their university studies: library, computer lab, language resource center, accommodation and a university cafeteria but also a shopping center, cinemas, a park and a lake.

Bachelor's degree in Law

Intended to provide with a general legal culture, this degree includes the compulsory basis necessary to understand and use judicial tools, through a theoretical and practical teaching of Public and Private Law, as well as through a juridical methodology learning.

Bachelor's degree in Economics

Allows students to develop their analytical skills in economics, to learn the principles of macroeconomics and microeconomics but also econometrics, statistics, computer science and modeling.

Bachelor's degree in Management

Stands as a general degree. Multidisciplinary studies allow the student to master judicial, economic and management datas. The program also includes subjects such as Political Science, Statistics, History and Sociology.

These three Bachelor's degrees are 3-years long (equivalent to 6 semesters). The first year offers special academic assistance (an orientation week, tutorials, classes with a limited size).
