Programmes for different needs



INTENSIVE PROGRAMME

Open to English-speaking students (Spanish-speaking students may also apply)

You take part in 20 hours of conversation throughout the semester.

You will need to submit a 400-word essay at the end of the semester.

Successful completion of the programme equates to 3 credits (ECTS).

OPEN PROGRAMME

Open to **Italian**, **Spanish** and **German** – speaking students.

Open to English-speaking students who prefer not to do the intensive programme.


You may stop taking part in the programme at any time.

No credits (ETS) are offered.




Service learning. How it works.

Come to the information meeting.
